Shredded paper

TELEVISIONS, COMPUTERS, AND OTHER ELECTRONICS

Best Buy and Staples will recycle all household electronic waste. Commercial e-waste should be taken to the Computer Recycling Center in Springfield. Visit computerrecyclingcenter.org or call (417) 866-2588.

CELL PHONES/RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

Best Buy, Staples, Target, U.S. Cellular, Radioshack, Laketronics, and Hollister Recycle Center recycle all electronics batteries and cell phones.

INK CARTRIDGES

Staples provides a \$3 credit for each ink cartridge, up to ten cartridges per month. Walgreens refills select ink cartridge brands.

PLASTIC BAGS & HANGERS

Wal-Mart, Target, Country Mart, and most grocery stores recycle plastic bags. JC Dry Cleaners recycles dry clean bags and hangers.

STYROFOAM AND PACKING PEANUTS

All UPS stores will take packing peanuts. All Points Recycling in Cassville recycles Styrofoam. Visit allpointsrecycling.com or call (417) 847-4258.

FURNITURE AND BUILDING SUPPLIES

Mountain Country "Homes of Hope" in Hollister takes usable furniture, building supplies, and working household appliances. Visit mchh.net/warehouse-store or call (851) 335-2015.

WHEN AND WHERE CAN I RECYCLE?

- Monday — Saturday from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- 24/7 recycle trailer at United Methodist Church
On 76 Blvd. Next to Veterans Museum

DO I NEED TO REMOVE LABELS?

No, you do not need to remove labels from soda bottles, milk and juice jugs, tin cans, etc.

DO I NEED TO REMOVE LIDS?

Yes, all plastic lids must be removed from soda bottles, milk jugs, laundry detergent containers, etc. They jam our machinery.

DO I HAVE TO SEPARATE RECYCLABLES?

Recyclables should be separated into:

- Paper (office, mixed, news, magazines)
- Shredded paper (please bag shredded)
- Cardboard
- Plastics #1-5
- Tin and aluminum cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- Household chemicals
